

Safeguarding Flowchart: What to do, by whom and by when

A Safeguarding concern is reported, or identified, by someone within the parish or anonymously

YES

Is the Child/Adult at Immediate Risk?

NO

If the person is at immediate risk of physical harm or needs medical attention, dial 999 to contact the Ambulance Service and/or the Police, and follow the advice given.

As soon as possible (but within 24hrs) follow the reporting and recording process on the right.

Record the concern (who, what, when, where, why, how?) within 24hrs of an issue having been raised, and file it securely with the Parish Safeguarding Representative or clergy.
If an incident is formally reported, then also report to the **Charity Commissioners**

Inform the Parish Clergy, and the Parish Safeguarding Rep. They will take action and will also...
